Reminder: it is illegal to place hazardous waste inside your garbage or recycle bin at your property. If hazardous waste is found in your bin, it will not be serviced until it is removed.

Hazardous Waste such as car batteries, fluorescent light bulbs, oil filters, paints, televisions, and more cannot go into your garbage or recycling container. For a list of hazardous waste please visit our website **www.westvalleyrecycles.com** or contact the Santa Clara County Household Hazardous Waste Program at **(408) 299-7300.** Larger quantities will need an independent hauler.

Businesses that generate small quantities of hazardous waste (less than 220 lbs or 27 gallons of hazardous waste per month) may qualify to use the County's Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generator (CESQG) program. To apply please visit **www.hhw.org.**

Trash is a significant pollutant of

California's waters that adversely affects aquatic life, wildlife, and public health. Trash from open carts and bins has a direct path to our storm drains which goes into our local creeks and the San Francisco Bay. The answer is simple. "Put a lid on it" by keeping the lid closed on garbage containers that are stored outside.

All businesses can apply good housekeeping practices in their trash container areas. Here are a few more tips!

- Keep garbage and recycling bin lids closed. This will prevent the contents from blowing out of the bin and keep out rainwater.
- Don't overfill the bin. Instead, increase service if there is overflow.
- Clean up all spills and leaks immediately using a spill kit with a dry absorbent.
