Holiday Tree Collection

Beginning December 27, 2021 and continuing through January 21, 2022, WVC&R will collect holiday trees under the following guidelines:



All trees must be cut into 5-foot or preferably shorter lengths.

Please remove stands, tinsel, lights and decorations.



Place the tree at least one foot away from WVC&R carts.

Flocked and decorated trees will not be collected.

SB 1383 – Organics Recycling is here, you can start today!

Tired of filling your trashcan to the brim with pizza boxes every time you order out? WVC&R gets it, which is why we are happy to announce the new Organics Recycling service in your area!

Organics such as food scraps and food soiled paper (i.e. paper towels and pizza boxes) can now be placed inside what was previously called the “yard waste” cart, so no need to worry about having a new cart delivered, your “organics” cart is already there! Every WVC&R customer is receiving Organics service at no additional cost, as well as a kitchen organics pail for your everyday food scraps like orange peels, egg shells, and pizza crusts! Expect to see a kitchen pail delivered near your mailbox before the end of 2021 and you can begin using it the day it arrives.

Never composted before? No worries! WVC&R will be providing an updated How-To Guide and a fully recyclable informational flyer on how to use your new kitchen organics pail and which items belong in your Organics cart.

The state of California recognizes the dangers of methane gas emissions and since 2014 has been working hard to reduce them. Landfills are California’s third-largest producer of methane gas emissions and most of those emissions come from compostable materials like food, green waste and, yes, pizza boxes. As such, Governor Newsom has passed Senate Bill (SB) 1383 requiring all homes and businesses to receive Organics Recycling service. It is the pleasure of WVC&R to be able to assist the state of California in its goal to give you a cleaner, greener tomorrow.

- Buy in bulk and skip the individual packaging.
- Pack sandwiches and snacks in reusable food containers.
- Use reusable water bottles, utensils, and cloth napkins.
- Carry lunches in a lunch box, bento box, or washable tote.
- Bring home uneaten fruits and vegetables and dispose of in your WVC&R organics cart.
